## Article 1448

When a dispute arising from an arbitration agreement is brought before a state court, that court shall decline jurisdiction unless the arbitral tribunal has not yet been seized of the matter and the arbitration agreement is manifestly void or manifestly inapplicable.

A state court may not raise its lack of jurisdiction of its own motion.

Any provision contrary to this article shall be deemed unwritten.
